CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1.GENERAL

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2019), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at main entrance to clubhouse.

2.ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is open to all Men and Women amateurs being full playing members of affiliated Golf Clubs. Men and women entering this tournament are restricted to a maximum playing handicap of 36.

3.ENTRY

Entry Fee is \$30 per team. The committee reserves the right to accept or decline any entry.

4.FORMAT

This is a foursomes strokeplay competition in two grades, men and women, completed over two rounds of 18 holes.

- Round One played in the morning will be Canadian Foursome (Both Players of a team tee off, select one ball and play alternately until holed out. Handicap 40% of combined).
- Round Two played in the afternoon will be Foursomes (Players of a team alternate with tee shots and subsequent shots until holed out. Handicap is 50% of combined).
- Winners are calculated on the combined total of these two rounds.
- Should the competition be called off in the afternoon due to inclement weather, the competition will be decided on the best scores from the morning round

5.DECISION ON TIES

In the case of two or more teams being tied at the conclusion of the second round, the winners will be determined on a count back over the last eighteen holes of that round, and if required, nine holes, six holes, three holes, and finally the eighteenth hole. The last nine, six and three holes are holes 10-18, 13-18 and 15 to 18. In such an event the handicap used will be the full handicap for the team on the second round, then half of that handicap, one third of that handicap and one sixth of that handicap. If teams remain tied after this process, the Title and Prizes will be determined by lot.

6.CARDS

On completion of each round scores must be checked, card signed by a player and a marker and promptly returned to the Matchroom. The card has then been officially returned.

7.COURSE

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material 'piled for removal' has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and MUST NOT be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

8.PACE OF PLAY

It is the players' responsibility to retain their pace of play in the field. Keep up with the group in front, call a following group through in lost ball situations, clear greens quickly on completion of play, and check scores and mark card at next tee. Position in the field is to be retained following the lunch break without delay.

9.DISPUTES

The Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play. The Disputes Committee's decision will be final. The Disputes Committee will comprise Richard Bullock, Grace Latimer and Rex Edwards.

10. COMPETITION CLOSURE

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving.
