CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1.GENERAL

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2019), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at the main entrance to Clubhouse.

2.ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is open to all Male amateurs being full playing members of Motueka Golf Club. The competition will be limited to the first 32 to place their name on the Entry Sheet. A list of reserves will be made to provide for any withdrawals prior to the competition start on Saturday 15th February.

3.ENTRY

Entry Fee is \$10 per player. The committee reserves the right to accept or decline any entry.

4.FORMAT

This is a 4BBB Matchplay on Handicap competition.

Match pairs and opponents will be drawn randomly for the first round. Rounds will be played 15 February, 14 March, 4 April (semi-finals) and 14 April (finals). Prior to each round, a starting draw will be posted on the Motuekagolf website. Matches are to be played on the day designated, but may be played prior to that date by mutual agreement of the players involved, and notification to the Match Chair. Members are to note that starting tees, once posted on the website, could be subject to change before commencement of play on the designated day.

First round losers will proceed to the Flight. Losing semi-finalists will contest the Plate.

5.CARDS

Scorecards are to be kept and a fully completed card returned for handicapping purposes. Any holes not played are to record a score of par plus the handicap stroke the player is entitled to receive. On completion of each round scores must be checked, card signed by a player and a marker and promptly returned to the Matchroom. The card has then been officially returned.

6. PRIZES

The winners of the Cup will be awarded the RP Rowling Trophy. Vouchers will be awarded to the winner and runners-up of the Cup, the winners of the Plate and the winners of the Flight.

7.COURSE

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material 'piled for removal' has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and MUST NOT be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

8.DISPUTES

The Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play of any match or as soon as practicable. The Disputes Committee's decision will be final. The Disputes Committee will comprise Kevin Armstrong and Rex Edwards.

9. COMPETITION CLOSURE

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving on 14 April.
