CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1.GENERAL

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2019), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at the main entrance to Clubhouse.

The Committee are mindful that there may be restrictions applied due to Covid Levels. The Committee will ensure that any restrictions are met and advise players accordingly.

2.ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is open to all Men and Women amateurs being full playing members of affiliated Golf Clubs.

3.ENTRY

Entry Fee is \$10 per player, plus \$2 for entry into the Twos competition. Payment is to be made on the day of tournament. The committee reserves the right to accept or decline any entry.

4.FORMAT

The Whitwells Open will be played over 18 holes of individual strokeplay in Mens and Ladies Grades. Play will commence at 12:30pm.

5.CARDS

Scorecards are to be kept and a fully completed card returned for handicapping. On completion scores must be checked, card signed by a player and a marker and promptly returned to the Matchroom. The card has then been officially returned.

6. START SHEET

A start sheet is available in the Clubhouse with entries closing at 3pm on Thursday 10th December. A tournament draw will be posted in the Motueka Golf Club Matchroom and on the Motueka Golf Club's website (<http://www.motuekagolf.co.nz/open-golf-tournaments>) from 5pm Thursday 10th December. Late entries will be accepted on the day of tournament.

7. DECISION ON TIES

In the event of a tie for any competition of the tournament the winners will be determined on countback.

8. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for gross and net scores in Ladies and Mens Grades and will comprise Whitwells vouchers of various denominations. There will also be a number of novelty prizes.

9. COURSE

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material 'piled for removal' has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and MUST NOT be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

10. DISPUTES

The Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play of any match or as soon as practicable. The Disputes Committee's decision will be final.

11. COMPETITION CLOSURE

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving.
