CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1.GENERAL

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2019), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at the main entrance to Clubhouse.

2.ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is open to all Men and Women amateurs being Full Playing members of affiliated Golf Clubs.

3.ENTRY

Entry Fee is \$20 per player, which includes entry into the Twos competition. The committee reserves the right to accept or decline any entry. **The tournament has been rescheduled from 4th September. Entries have closed and the field is fully subscribed.**

4.FORMAT

The New World Open will be played over 18 holes of individual strokeplay in Mens and Ladies Grades. Play will commence by Shotgun start at 11:30am. This is a Tasman District Tier 1 Tournament.

5.CARDS

Scorecards are to be kept and a fully completed card returned for handicapping. On completion scores must be checked, card signed by a player and a marker and promptly returned to the Matchroom. The card has then been officially returned.

6. START SHEET

A tournament draw will be posted in the Motueka Golf Club Matchroom and on the Motueka Golf Club's website [Motueka Golf Club Open Tournaments](#) by Friday 20th November.

7. DECISION ON TIES

In the event of a tie for any competition of the tournament the winners will be determined on countback.

8. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for gross and net scores in Ladies and Mens Grades. There will also be a number of novelty prizes, including a hole-in-one prize on any hole. The latter invalidates any other sponsored hole-in-one prize.

9. COURSE

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material 'piled for removal' has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and MUST NOT be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

10. DISPUTES

The Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play of any match or as soon as practicable. The Disputes Committee's decision will be final.

11. COMPETITION CLOSURE

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving.
