Conditions of Competition

1. *General*

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2019), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at the main entrance to Clubhouse

The Committee are mindful that there may be restrictions applied due to Covid Levels. The Committee will ensure that any restrictions are met and advise players accordingly.

2. *Eligibility*

The tournament is open to all Men and Women amateurs being full playing members of affiliated Golf Clubs.

3. *Entry*

The entry fee is \$60 per pair. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or decline any entry without explanation. Entries close at 3pm on Thursday 30th September 2021. However, entries may be accepted on the first day of competition (Saturday), subject to numbers in the field permitting.

Entry to Twos which will run concurrent with the 4BBB and Individual Nett rounds is \$5.

4. *Format*

The championship will be played over 18 holes of four ball best ball stroke play followed by 18 holes of foursomes stroke play on Saturday 2nd October 2021 then 18 holes of individual stroke play on Sunday 3rd October 2021.

If inclement weather or for any other reason the event is disrupted, the Committee may alter the format and the number of holes played. Suspension of play, if required, will be signalled by air horn if play is underway, or otherwise advised on the Clubs website – www.motuekagolf.co.nz.

5. *Handicaps*

Handicaps for the entirety of the Tournament will be fixed to 2nd October 2021. The team handicap for the Foursome rounds will be 50% of combined.

6. *Tournament score cards*

- For the 4BBB round, each player is required to complete an individual card recording their gross score for each hole. Any hole not completed is to be marked “NS” (no score). **Partners must not mark each other’s cards.**
- On the foursome card only the gross score is to be recorded.
- For Individual Nett round, all players must complete their supplied individual card.

On completion of each round scores should be **checked**, card **signed** by the player and the marker (if the Covid Level in force permits) and promptly returned to the McCarthy Matchroom. The card has then been officially returned.

7 *Start Sheet*

A copy of the tournament draw for both days will be posted in the Motueka Golf Club Matchroom window, at the clubhouse and on the Motueka Golf Club’s website <http://www.motuekagolf.co.nz/open-golf-tournaments> by 5pm Thursday 30th September.

8. *Decisions of Ties*

All ties will be decided by count back. The rounds used will be, in the following order, Lowest individual nett round, Foursomes, then 4BBB. Should there still be a tie it will be decided by lot.

9. *Prizes*

Prizes will be awarded for combined scores in Ladies and Mens Grades. There will also be a number of novelty prizes.

Players are restricted to one prize only, apart from novelty prizes and the Spring Cup.

The Spring Cup will be awarded to the lowest nett round on Sunday by a Motueka Golf Club member.

The player having the first ‘hole in one’ for the two days of the tournament on hole number 17, will win the Whitwells sponsored prize.

10. *Course*

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material ‘piled for removal’ has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and **MUST NOT** be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

11. *Disputes*

The Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play of any match or as soon as practicable. The Disputes Committee’s decision will be final.

12. *Competition Closure*

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving.
