

NBS Motueka Golf Club
18 HOLE LADIES CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS
2024 Conditions of Competition

1. General

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2024), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at the main entrance to Clubhouse.

2. Eligibility

The tournament is open to all female amateurs being full playing 18 hole members of Motueka Golf Club.

3. Entry

There is no entry fee, however, the Match Committee (MC) reserves the right to accept or decline any entry.
Grades will be as per the 2024 LGU Divisions:

Silver : 0 - 18.4

Bronze 1: 18.5 - 26.2

Bronze 2: 26.3 - 54

4. Format

Top 16 in each grade qualify and are seeded in relation to the best 18 hole strokeplay qualifying round.

Where there are less than 16 players in a grade, byes will be allocated in the first round. Where there are less than 6 players byes will be allocated in the first and second rounds.

First round losers will proceed to the Flight. Losing semi-finalists will contest the Plate.

Matches are to be played on the designated day or no later than the Friday before the next designated round.

Any match to be played on a date outside of the designated week must be approved by the Match Chair. If a date cannot be agreed on between the two players, the Ladies Club Captain and Match Chair are to be advised as soon as possible, so a decision can be made before the nominated date. If either the Match Chair or Ladies Club Captain is involved in, or directly affected, by the outcome of the pending decision, that person will not be involved in the review and decision process.

6. Finals

All club finalists (men's, women's and 9 hole) will be played on Saturday October 12th 2024.

7. Course

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material 'piled for removal' has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and MUST NOT be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

8. Disputes

The Match Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play of any match or as soon as practicable. The Disputes Committee's decision will be final.

9. Competition Closure

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving.
