9 HOLE LADIES CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS
2025 Conditions of Competition

1. General

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf (effective January 2023), together with the Local Rules as drawn up by the Motueka Committee. Please read the Local and Temporary Local Rules Boards at the main entrance to Clubhouse.

2. Eligibility

The tournament is open to all female amateurs being full playing 9 hole members of Motueka Golf Club.

3. Entry

Entries close on 22/08/2025 and there is no entry fee. The Grades will be as per the following indexes:

Div1: 0 – 36.0 Div 2: 36.1 – 54.0

4. Format

The format is Match Play off the stick, in two groups. Matches can be played on a set date, or any day before the next round. If it rains matches can be postponed.

All games are to be played on the back 9, and a toss of the coin will determine who tees off first.

If all square at the end of the match, the following holes will be played until the match is won, 10, 11, 12, 13 etc.

All the rules of Match play must be adhered to.

Motorised carts or bikes may be used in local competitions at the discretion of the Match Committee.

The Draw will be seeded based on Handicaps as at 22/8/25, with the first round starting on 2/9/25 and finishes by 8/9/25 The second round starts 9/9/25 and finishes by 15/9/25. Winner and Runner up in both divisions to play at the Best of the Best.

The match committee for the 2025 championships are: Diane Enoke, Iren Fell and Meredith Rayner.

6. Finals

All club finalists (men's, women's and 9 hole) will be played on Sunday September 28th, 2025.

7. Course

All areas of GUR will be marked. All material 'piled for removal' has been removed. All advertising signs are Immovable Obstructions and MUST NOT be moved. Relief for interference of STANCE or SWING (not line of play) is available under Rules 15 and 16.

8. Disputes

The Match Committee reserve the right to penalise any player the applicable penalty for failure to comply with the Tournament Conditions of the Competition. Any dispute or protest must be submitted to the Disputes Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of play of any match or as soon as practicable. The Disputes Committee's decision will be final.

9. Competition Closure

The Competition is closed once the winners have been announced at the prize giving.
